RULES

- The Grand Bay Watermelon Festival is a family event and **smoking is not allowed** in the Festival area. **Pets are also not allowed** in the Festival area. **No alcohol is allowed anywhere in the park.**
- Vendors may set up on July 3rd from 10 am to 2:30 pm.
- All vendors **must** have vehicles moved from festival area between the hours of **2:30 pm – 7 pm** on July 3rd; and **9:30 am – 5 pm** on July 4th. **ABSOLUTELY NO vehicles allowed** back to your booth outside of designated times. You **must** check in with the Event Coordinator before set-up.
- Reserved vendor parking is available on top of the hill, provided by Festival Committee. On site camping in Vendor parking is available, with prior notice, for tent camping or completely self-contained campers.
- **If you are a first-time vendor with us**, please provide at least 3 photos of your entertainment.
- The Grand Bay Watermelon Festival Committee reserves the right to refuse space to any vendor who does not comply with these rules. Any vendor not complying with rules and/or conducts themselves in an unprofessional manner will be asked to leave the grounds. **All decisions are FINAL.**
- Entertainment vendors are **required** to provide a Certificate of Insurance (COI) of \$2,000,000.00 listing Grand Bay Watermelon Festival as 'Certificate Holder' (Additionally Insured). - Each Entertainment will be monitored for safety by vendor or vendor representative.
- All entertainment spaces will be assigned by Event Coordinator. Call for more information.
- FEES: Entertainment – 20% of proceeds per vendor. At this time, we do not have Sponsors for children's rides. If that changes, I will let you know. No fees will be charged for electricity.
